RESIDENTS SHOULD MOVE ALL BASKETBALL HOOPS BEHIND THE SIDEWALK. DRIVERS CANNOT ALWAYS SEE THEM. THEY SHOULD NOT BE ON TOWN PROPERTY.

PLEASE OBSERVE ALL PARKING BANS AS THEY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. THE BANS ARE POSTED ON GOVERNMENT TV, THE TOWN'S WEBSITE, AND NEWS CHANNELS 3, 8, AND 30.

PLEASE KEEP BACK 100 FEET BEHIND PLOW TRUCKS TO AVOID ACCIDENTS. DRIVERS ARE CONSTANTLY STOPPING AND BACKING UP AND MAY NOT SEE YOU.

TOWN ORDINANCE #593, ARTICLE 3, PROHIBITS DISCHARGE OR PILING SNOW IN PUBLIC ROADWAYS. PLEASE INFORM THE CONTRACTOR THAT PLOWS YOUR PROPERTY OF SUCH.

GARBAGE CANS SHOULD NOT BE PLACED IN THE STREET.
