SUBJECT: PIERCE REORGANIZATION

On February 14, 1989, the Town Council approved a contract between the IBEW, Local #457 and the Electric Division. Part of that approval involved the reorganization of the Pierce Station. As part of that reorganization, a modified job description, job title and salary adjustment were accomplished. It is necessary to amend the personnel pages of the 1988 - 1989 budget to reflect the increase in salary and the new job title.

Job Title: Turbine Utility Operator

Salary: Step 1 - \$10.25, Step 2 - \$10.83, Step 3 - \$11.41,  
Step 4 - \$11.99, Step 5 - \$12.62, Step 6 - \$13.21,  
Step 7 - \$13.79, Step 8 - \$14.37, Step 9 - \$15.00

This reorganization at the Pierce Plant allows flexibility and is a positive step for the Division as a whole.
