Gentlemen:

The position of Electrician has proved to be an extremely difficult slot to fill at the Electric Division. Significant time and effort has gone into advertising and interviewing, only to find that the few candidates who were qualified were not interested in the position.

Therefore, I am asking that this position be downgraded to that of Apprentice Electrician, in this case only. This would allow the normal progression from an entry level position, Apprentice, to that of a full Electrician. This change would require no additional funding, as monies were budgeted in the 1988 - 1989 fiscal budget.
